

Hand Percentages Chart*

The first column in the chart below represents the specific hand, while the center column gives the chance of that hand appearing for any one player. The third column represents the cumulative chance of a hand at least as good as the hand listed in column one. For example, the chance of your opponent holding JJ or better is 3% while the chance that they hold JJ specifically is 0.45%. Remember to adjust your estimates if your opponent has already acted and shown some strength.

* The ordering of the chart above is a representation of what players have called all-in bets with in situations where the blinds are very high compared to the stack sizes at the end of a sit and go tournament. This data was pulled from over 2 million hands collected in PokerTracker by five different players who frequently play sit and go tournaments.

This includes over 300,000 hands from my own database.

The order of the hands does not represent how strong hand actually is in any given situation, but it does serve to give you an idea of how often, percentage wise, your opponent will actually call you. If you think they will call with AA, KK, QQ and AKs then you can look at the chart and see that your bet will be only be called 1.65% of the time. Becoming familiar with what percentage of the total hands certain ranges cover will be a great help when you are late in a single table tournament, and will be particularly helpful when you are working with an ICM to perfect your end game play.
